



The intent of this first iteration of nowherenadio was to give people the opportunity to adjust the outcome of an art exhibit through participation. Is it possible for art to work as a broadcast? The function of interactivity can create a relationship between the participant and the broadcast. The relationship becomes intriguing when we an audience becomes a momentary community and a set of exchanges of ideas and expressions through the broadcast range.

n o where eradio is composed of experimental sound devices and instruments, microphones, armatures, a mixer, digital processors and a low powered FM transmitter, it is designed to be highly transportable and can run on the battery of a standard car. Participants are encouraged to create their own sounds and generate their own projected and broadcasted thoughts and ideas.




